Supervisor of Elections Mails Domestic Ballots for April 21 Special General Election, State Representative, District 64; and Redington Shores, District 2 Municipal Election

Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Deborah Clark mailed **15,477 ballots** to domestic voters **today (March 17, 2015)** for the April 21, 2015 Special General Election, State Representative District 64 and Redington Shores, District 2 Municipal Election.

Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Pinellas County.

Additional mail ballot requests will be fulfilled as received. To request a mail ballot, visit VotePinellas.com, call (727) 464-VOTE (8683), or email Absentee@VotePinellas.com and include date of birth. **The deadline to request that a ballot be mailed is April 15 at 5:00 p.m.**

Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. Please note, postal delivery service has changed. Voters are advised to allow at least 5 days for their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections office.

Details regarding early voting and ballot drop-off locations will be released at a later date.
