Ballots Mailed to Military and Overseas Voters for March 10 Municipal Elections

Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Deborah Clark said a total of **94** ballots were mailed for the March 10 Municipal Elections to absent military and overseas voters today (January 23) as follows:

Eight municipalities are conducting elections on March 10: Town of Belleair, City of Belleair Beach, City of Indian Rocks Beach, Town of Kenneth City, City of Oldsmar, City of Safety Harbor, City of St. Pete Beach and City of Treasure Island.

A ballot mailing to more than 16,700 domestic voters is tentatively scheduled for February 3.

Absent military and overseas voters include all active-duty military, their spouses and dependents, currently absent from their places of residence; and civilians who are U.S. citizens residing outside the United States. Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Pinellas County.
