City of Tarpon Springs No. 10 Charter Amendment: Amending Street and Sidewalk Investment Fund and Creating the Sidewalk Improvement Fund. Sponsored by Charter Revision Commission. The City Charter created a street and sidewalk investment fund to support street, drainage, and sidewalk improvements. The Charter Revision Commission has determined that the funds could be better utilized to effectuate sidewalk improvements throughout the City.
