## **General Information**

**Voter Eligibility:** You are eligible to register to vote if you are a U.S. citizen, age 18 or older, and a legal resident of the county in which you are registering.

Florida's Closed Primary Elections: If all candidates for an office have the same party affiliation and the winner of the primary will have no opposition in the general election, all eligible voters, regardless of party affiliation, may vote in the primary election for that office. Otherwise, the primary is closed, and only voters registered with a political party may vote in that party's primary.


