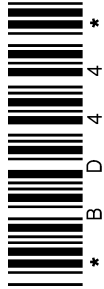


# VOTING INSTRUCTIONS (F.S. 101.65)

1. Use a black ballpoint pen to vote your ballot. Vote your ballot in secret.
2. If you make a mistake, call for a new ballot at 727-464-VOTE (8683).
3. Vote for only one candidate or issue choice in each contest, unless otherwise indicated on the ballot.
4. Place your ballot in the secrecy sleeve.
5. Put the secrecy sleeve in your return envelope and seal.
6. **SIGN YOUR NAME ON THE BACK OF YOUR RETURN ENVELOPE.** The signature on your return envelope will be compared to your signature on the voter record.
7. Check box if you want to keep voting by mail.
8. Print the date under your signature.
9. Mail your ballot or take it to any ballot drop-off location (*see back of this page*).
10. **71 cents** postage (or two forever stamps) required to mail. (*Active duty military voters, spouses, and dependents are not required to pay postage.*)
11. If returning your ballot by mail, download your "I Voted By Mail" Sticker! (*see below*).

**YOUR BALLOT CANNOT BE COUNTED IF:**

- **You did not sign the back of your return envelope** (*unless otherwise provided in F.S. 101.68*)
- **The signature on the return envelope does not match your signature on your voter record** (*unless otherwise provided in F.S. 101.68*) To update your signature for this election, submit a Florida Voter Registration Application before we begin processing ballots, which may be as early as 15 days before the election. It is important to be consistent when writing your legal signature.
- **Your ballot is not received by 7:00 p.m. Election Day, November 6, 2018.**
