Voter Eligibility: You are eligible to register to vote if you are a U.S. citizen, age 18 or older, and a legal resident of the county in which you want to register.

Florida's Closed Primary Elections: Although party affiliation is not a registration requirement, only voters registered with a political party can vote in that party's primary elections. All eligible voters, regardless of party affiliation, may vote in nonpartisan contests, and universal primary elections in which all candidates for an office have the same party affiliation, if the winner of the primary will have no opposition in the general election. 
