**VOTER TURNOUT HISTORY**: Aug. 2013 – 50,471 ballots cast = 31.38% (Mayor, Dist. 4, 6, 8)

Last 5 Primary Elections Aug. 2011 – 2,875 ballots cast = 14.25% (Dist. 1)

Sept. 2009 – 36,733 ballots cast = 23.27% (Mayor, Dist. 4, 5, 6)

Sept. 2007 – 4,530 ballots cast = 11.10% (Dist. 3, 5) Sept. 2005 – 4,033 voters = 10.55% (Dist. 4, 6)
