Voters Encouraged to Update Addresses Before Going to the Polls

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections encourages voters to update their voter registration information – including their addresses – prior to going to an early voting site or their Election Day polling place.

“By updating their addresses now, voters can avoid an unnecessary delay when casting their ballots,” said Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Deborah Clark. “In addition, voters who have moved within Pinellas County or from other Florida counties should update their addresses in order to know their correct polling place prior to voting.”

Each voter will receive a two-sided ballot with 11 ballot questions for the November 8 General Election. All eligible voters can enjoy the convenience of voting by mail. The deadline to request that a ballot be mailed is Wednesday, November 2 at 5:00 p.m.
