ELECTION DAY CHECKLIST FOR VOTERS

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections reminds voters to complete the below checklist before heading to the polls on Election Day:

- ✓ Polling places will be open 7:00 a.m.–7:00 p.m.
- ✓ Confirm your polling place by visiting <u>VotePinellas.com</u> and clicking on the "Find Your Precinct" button at the top of the page, or calling 727-464-VOTE (8683).
 - State law requires voters to vote in the precinct in which they reside. Voters who have moved are required to vote in their new home precinct. Voters are encouraged, prior to going to a polling place, to make any address changes either online at VotePinellas.com; by calling 727-464-VOTE (8683); or emailing Election@VotePinellas.com (include birth date).
- ✓ Bring valid and current photo and signature identification to the polls to avoid delays. Anyone without valid and current ID may vote a provisional ballot.
- ✓ Download your sample ballot at <u>VotePinellas.com</u> and bring your marked sample ballot with you to your polling place.
