ELECTION DAY CHECKLIST FOR VOTERS

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections reminds voters to complete the below checklist before heading to the polls on Election Day:

- ✓ Polling places will be open 7:00 a.m.–7:00 p.m.
- ✓ Confirm your polling place by visiting VotePinellas.com and clicking on the “Find Your Precinct” button at the top of the page, or calling 727-464-VOTE (8683).
 - State law requires voters to vote in the **precinct in which they reside**. Voters who have moved are required to vote in their **new** home precinct. Voters are encouraged, prior to going to a polling place, to make any address changes either online at VotePinellas.com; by calling 727-464-VOTE (8683); or emailing Election@VotePinellas.com (include birth date).
- ✓ Bring valid and current [photo and signature identification](#) to the polls to avoid delays. Anyone without valid and current ID may vote a provisional ballot.
- ✓ Download your sample ballot at VotePinellas.com and bring your marked sample ballot with you to your polling place.
