REMINDER: Deadline to Register to Vote in the November 8 General Election is TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections reminds voters that <u>TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11</u> is the deadline to register to vote in the November 8, 2016 General Election.

- ✓ All three Supervisor of Elections Offices will be open: <u>Saturday, October 8, from 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.</u> <u>Monday, October 10, from 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.</u> <u>Tuesday, October 11, from 8:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m.</u>
- ✓ Election Ambassadors will be available at each Pinellas County Tax Collector Office on Monday, October 10 and Tuesday, October 11 from 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. to assist anyone needing to register to vote, update their voter registration information or make a mail ballot request.

Registration is required for new voters by this deadline in order to participate in the General Election.

Name changes may be made by sending a signed, written statement to the Supervisor of Elections Office including birth date or voter ID number. Any updates, including signatures and political party affiliation, can be made by completing and signing a voter registration application and returning it to the Supervisor of Elections Office.

All new applications received by mail must be postmarked by **Tuesday, October 11** in order to be valid for the November 8, 2016 General Election.
