Supervisor of Elections to Mail and Publish Sample Ballots

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections has mailed the official sample ballot for the November 8 General Election to households with registered voters to help voters prepare for Election Day.

The sample ballot will also be published in the Friday, October 21 edition of the Tampa Bay Times as part of a special insert. In addition, the sample ballot will be published in the Thursday, October 20 edition of The Weekly Challenger.

The official sample ballot, which includes contests and questions for all districts within Pinellas County, is also available online at VotePinellas.com, along with precinct-specific sample ballots.

Voters are encouraged to use the sample ballot to get election ready. They can mark their choices on the sample ballot, and bring it with them during early voting or on Election Day.

Each voter will receive a two-sided ballot with 11 ballot questions. All eligible voters may enjoy the convenience of voting by mail.
