Ballots Mailed to Military and Overseas Voters for March 15 Presidential Preference Primary and Municipal Elections

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Office mailed a total of **1,579** ballots to absent military and overseas voters today (January 29) for the March 15, 2016 Presidential Preference Primary and Municipal Elections.

Absent military and overseas voters include all active-duty military, their spouses and dependents currently absent from their places of residence, and civilians who are U.S. citizens residing outside the United States.

A ballot mailing to more than 203,000 domestic voters is tentatively scheduled for **February 9.** State law requires domestic ballots to be mailed between 35 and 28 days prior to an election. Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Pinellas County.
