PLEASE NOTE: Postal delivery service has changed. Voters are advised to allow at least 5 days for their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections office. Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Mail ballots may be dropped off at any of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices. Voters may also drop their ballot at one of 12 remote ballot drop-off sites throughout Pinellas County through March 14. Check VotePinellas.com for hours and locations. Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places.
