PLEASE NOTE: Postal delivery service has changed. <u>Voters are advised to allow at least 5 days for their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections office</u>. Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Mail ballots may be dropped off at any of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices. Voters may also drop their ballot at one of 12 remote ballot drop-off sites throughout Pinellas County through March 14. Check <u>VotePinellas.com</u> for hours and locations. Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places.
