PINELLAS COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS OFFICE MAILING MORE THAN 200,000 BALLOTS TO DOMESTIC VOTERS ON FEBRUARY 9

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Office will mail more than 200,000 ballots to domestic voters on Tuesday, February 9 for the March 15 Presidential Preference Primary and Municipal Elections.

Approximately 17 pallets, each stacked 5 feet high with ballots, will be loaded from the warehouse into a large delivery truck.

Since 2010, more than half of all ballots cast in Pinellas County elections have been mail ballots. In the 2012 Presidential Preference Primary, 59% of all ballots cast were mail ballots.
