### REMOTE BALLOT DROP-OFF SITES AVAILABLE FOR MARCH 15 PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY AND MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Office reminds voters that remote ballot drop-off sites are available for the March 15 Presidential Preference Primary and Municipal Elections.

The following remote ballot drop-off sites will be available **February 29 – March 14** during specified hours; **some** locations are open Saturdays - **all are closed on Election Day**. - Five Tax Collector Offices:
  - Tarpon Springs – 743 Pinellas Ave. S., Tarpon Springs
  - North County – 29399 US Hwy. 19 N., Clearwater
  - Gulf to Bay – 1663 Gulf to Bay Blvd., Clearwater
  - South County – 1800 66th St. N., St. Petersburg
  - Skyway Plaza – 1067 62nd Ave. S., St. Petersburg
- Five Public Libraries:

  - Oldsmar Public Library – 400 St. Petersburg Dr. E, Oldsmar
  - Seminole Community Library – 9200 113<sup>th</sup> St. N, Seminole

  - James Weldon Johnson Branch Library – 1059 18<sup>th</sup> Ave. S, St. Petersburg

Election employees are stationed with secure ballot boxes **inside** each location to assist and hand out “I Voted” stickers. Voted mail ballots can also be dropped off at any of the three Elections Offices.

**Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. Please note, postal delivery service has changed. Voters are advised to allow at least 5 days for their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections Office.** Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places. The deadline to request that a ballot be mailed is March 9, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.
