## REMOTE BALLOT DROP-OFF SITES AVAILABLE FOR AUGUST 30 PRIMARY ELECTION

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections reminds voters that beginning **Monday, August 15,** remote ballot drop-off sites are available for the August 30 Primary Election.

The following remote ballot drop-off sites will be available **Monday, August 15 – Monday, August 29** during specified hours; **some** locations are open Saturdays – **all are <u>closed on Election Day</u>**. A complete schedule is included in mail ballot kits and also available online at <u>VotePinellas.com</u>:

Election employees are stationed with secure ballot boxes **inside** each location to assist and hand out "I Voted" stickers. Voted mail ballots may also be dropped off at any of the three Elections Offices.

Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. Voters are advised to allow at least 5 days for their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections Office. Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places. To request a mail ballot, visit VotePinellas.com, call (727) 464-VOTE (8683) or email MailBallot@VotePinellas.com. The deadline to request that a ballot be mailed is August 24 at 5:00 p.m.
