JULY 31 is the Deadline to Register to Vote in St. Petersburg Primary Election

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections reminds residents in the City of St. Petersburg that **MONDAY, JULY 31** is the deadline to register to vote in the August 29, 2017 Primary Election.

Registration is required for new voters by this deadline in order to participate in the Primary Election. Voters who are already registered to vote in Florida do not need to re-register but can update their voter registration address.

Voter registration applications are available at any Supervisor of Elections office, public library, tax collector office, government office handling social services or online at <u>VotePinellas.com</u>.

Address changes can be made online at <u>VotePinellas.com</u>, by calling (727) 464-VOTE (8683) or by emailing <u>Election@VotePinellas.com</u>, with birth date included. Any updates, including name changes, signatures and political party affiliation, can be made by completing and signing a voter registration application and returning it to the Supervisor of Elections Office.

All new voter registration applications received by mail must be postmarked by **Monday, July 31** in order to be valid for the August 29 Primary Election.
