Supervisor of Elections Mails Domestic Ballots For March 14 Municipal Elections

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections mailed **26,512** ballots today (February 7) to domestic voters residing in the 10 municipalities conducting elections on March 14:

- All eligible registered voters can request a mail ballot and vote in the comfort of their homes
- Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day
- Please note, postal delivery service has changed. <u>Voters are advised to allow at least ONE WEEK for their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections Office</u>
- Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places

Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Pinellas County.
