## FEBRUARY 13 is the Deadline to Register to Vote in March 14 Municipal Elections

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections reminds residents in 10 municipalities conducting elections on March 14 that MONDAY, FEBRUARY 13 is the deadline to register to vote in these municipal elections.

Registration is required for new voters in Gulfport, Indian Rocks Beach, Madeira Beach, North Redington Beach, Redington Shores, Safety Harbor, South Pasadena, St. Pete Beach, Tarpon Springs and Treasure Island (District 1 & 3 only) by this deadline in order to participate in the March 14 Municipal Elections. Voters who are already registered to vote in Florida do not need to re-register but can update their voter registration address.

Voter registration applications are available at any Supervisor of Elections office, public library, tax collector office, government office handling social services or online at VotePinellas.com.

Name changes may be made by sending a signed, written statement to the Supervisor of Elections Office including birth date or voter ID number. Any updates, including signatures and political party affiliation, can be made by completing and signing a voter registration application and returning it to the Supervisor of Elections Office.

All new voter registration applications received by mail must be postmarked by Monday, February 13 in order to be valid for the March 14 Municipal Elections.
