Supervisor of Elections Mails Domestic Ballots for November 7 County Referendum and Municipal General Elections

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections mailed **258,857** ballots today (October 3) to domestic voters for the November 7, 2017 County Referendum and Municipal General Elections.

- All eligible registered voters can request a mail ballot and vote in the comfort of their homes
- Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day
- <u>Voters are advised to allow at least ONE WEEK for their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections Office</u>
- Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places

Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Pinellas County.

Additional mail ballot requests will be fulfilled as received. To request a mail ballot, visit <u>VotePinellas.com</u>, call 727-464-VOTE (8683) or email <u>MailBallot@VotePinellas.com</u>. The deadline to request that a ballot be mailed is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 1.
