Mail ballots may be dropped off at any of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices. Mail ballots may also be dropped off at one of 12 remote ballot drop-off sites throughout Pinellas County October 28 – November 6. Check [VotePinellas.com](http://VotePinellas.com) for hours and locations. Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places on Election Day.
