Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Mail ballots may be dropped off at any of the three Supervisor of Elections Offices. Mail ballots may also be dropped off at one of 12 remote ballot drop-off sites throughout Pinellas County October 28 – November 6. Check <u>VotePinellas.com</u> for hours and locations. Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places on Election Day.
