### **Ballots Mailed to Military and Overseas Voters for May 2 St. Petersburg Special Election Referendum**

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Office mailed a total of **1,062** ballots to absent military and overseas voters today (March 17) for the May 2, 2017 St. Petersburg Special Election Referendum.

Absent military and overseas voters include all active-duty military, their spouses and dependents currently absent from their places of residence, and civilians who are U.S. citizens residing outside the United States.

A ballot mailing to approximately 67,000 domestic voters is tentatively scheduled for **March 28**. State law requires domestic ballots to be mailed between 35 and 28 days prior to an election. Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Pinellas County.
