Wednesday, April 26 is Deadline for Voters to Request a Ballot to be Mailed for May 2 St. Petersburg Special Election Referendum

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections reminds voters in the City of St. Petersburg that <u>5:00 p.m.</u> <u>Wednesday, April 26</u> is the deadline to request a ballot to be mailed for the May 2, 2017 St. Petersburg Special Election Referendum.

All eligible registered voters can request a mail ballot and vote in the comfort of their homes. To request a mail ballot, visit VotePinellas.com, call (727) 464-VOTE (8683) or email MailBallot@VotePinellas.com. Ballots may also be picked up in Supervisor of Elections Offices; however, mail ballot pickup and voting in Elections Offices on Election Day is only permitted in the case of an emergency.

Please note, postal delivery service has changed. <u>Voters are advised to allow at least ONE WEEK for</u> their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections Office. Voted mail ballots can also be dropped off at any of the three Elections Offices, including on Election Day.

All ballots must be *received* at an Elections Office by **7:00 p.m. on Election Day**. All accepted mail ballots are included in election results.

Voters may track their ballot status online at <u>VotePinellas.com</u> to find out when their ballot was mailed and when their voted ballot was received by the Supervisor of Elections.
