Supervisor of Elections Mails Domestic Ballots For March 13 Municipal Elections

The Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections mailed 58,537 ballots today (February 6) to domestic voters residing in the 12 municipalities conducting elections on March 13:

All eligible registered voters can request a mail ballot and vote in the comfort of their homes

- Voted mail ballots must be received at one of the three Elections Offices by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day
- <u>Voters are advised to allow at least ONE WEEK for their ballot to be returned by mail to the Supervisor of Elections Office</u>
- Voted mail ballots cannot be accepted at polling places

Domestic voters are civilian voters residing within the United States and active-duty military voters residing in Pinellas County.
