March 23 is Deadline to Register to Vote for April 21 Special General Election, State Representative, District 64; and Redington Shores, District 2, Municipal Election

Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections Deborah Clark reminds voters that <u>MONDAY, MARCH 23</u> is the deadline to register to vote or change political party affiliations for the April 21, 2015 Special General Election, State Representative District 64 and Redington Shores, District 2 Municipal Election.

Registration is required for new voters by this deadline in order to participate in the election. Voters who are already registered to vote in Florida do not need to re-register.

Address changes can be made online at <u>VotePinellas.com</u> or by calling (727) 464-VOTE (8683) or emailing <u>Election@VotePinellas.com</u>, with birth date included. Name and party changes may be made by sending a signed, written statement to the Supervisor of Elections including birth date or voter ID number. Any updates, including signatures, can be made by completing and signing a voter registration application and returning it to the Supervisor of Elections. All new applications received by mail must be postmarked by **Monday, March 23** in order to be valid for this election.

Voter registration applications are available at any Supervisor of Elections office, public library, tax collector office, government office handling social services or online at VotePinellas.com.
